CHAPTER II

I. THE PARTICULARS OF ORGANIZATION, FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES:

New & Renewable Energy Development Corporation of Andhra Pradesh Ltd., (NREDCAP) formerly known as Agro Pumpsets & Implements Ltd., (APIL) and subsequently renamed as Non-conventional Energy Development Corporation of AP Ltd., (NEDCAP) is a Nodal Agency of Government of Andhra Pradesh. The Corporation was incorporated on 21.10.1969. Later, it was renamed as NEDCAP in the year 1986 and as NREDCAP during June 2011.

NEDCAP OBJECTIVES:

1. To survey, develop and implement renewable energy programmes of State and Central Governments.
2. Generation of electricity through renewable sources like wind and solar on decentralized and centralized methods.
3. Conservation of energy in rural areas.
4. Ensure post-installation service and adoption viable technology.
5. To impart viable technology and machines in the area of non-conventional energy sources.
6. To impart training and to promote research and development in the field of non-conventional energy sources.
7. To ensure proper utilization of funds provided by the State and Central Governments with efficient management system.

FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE ORGANIZATION:

NEDCAP is implementing all non-conventional energy programmes sponsored by both State and Central Governments and are as follows:

- National Biogas and Manure Management Programme
- Improved Chulhas (State Government Programme)

- Wind Energy
- Solar Energy

- Biomass production, conversion and utilization technology
- Power Generation through Non-Conventional Energy Sources - Mini Hydel Projects.
- Power Generation through Non-Conventional Energy Sources - Industrial & Municipal solid waste based power projects
- Energy Conservation Programmes

The programme/activity wise brief details are:

1 NATIONAL BIOGAS AND MANURE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME (CENTRAL GOVERNMENT PROGRAMME):

“NEDCAP” is the State Nodal agency for Andhra Pradesh State to implement all Renewable Energy Programmes.

The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE), Govt. of India, New Delhi is providing Central Financial Assistance(CFA) under National Biogas & Manure Management programme (NBMMP). NEDCAP has installed around 3.77 lakh Biogas up to 2009-10 in the State.

For the year 2009-10 we have received an amount of Rs.11,71,02,563/- and utilized the same for construction of 12,861 No. of Biogas Plants.

2. IMPROVED CHULHAS (STATE GOVERNMENT PROGRAMME):

The Government of Andhra Pradesh has sanctioned and released an amount of Rs. 86.00 lakhs to take up the Improved Chulhas Programme during the year 2009-10. The cost and subsidy available details for different models of chulhas are as follows.

NEDCAP has constructed/ distributed 45,500 No. of Improved Chulhas during the year 2009-10.

3. WIND ENERGY:

The power generation through wind is environmental friendly and has a very short gestation period. NEDCAP with the support of MNRE has taken up wind monitoring studies at 75 locations in Andhra Pradesh and 32 sites have been identified with an annual wind power density of 200 watts / sq.mtr at 50 Mtr level for wind power development.

The wind power potential in the State is estimated at 8,968 MW based on the wind resource studies conducted. The potential is estimated on the assumption that 1% of land becomes available for Wind farming and the area required for 1 MW wind farm project as 12 hectares. The A.P. State stands 3rd in the country in wind power potential after Gujarat and Karnataka States.

The State Govt. has announced policy only during April, 2008 / Sept, 2008 and a tariff of Rs.3.50 ps/KWh is offered for wind power projects. The APERC has consented the tariff and subsequently approved the standard PPA format and also power evacuation guidelines on 30th March,2010.

143.37 MW capacity wind power projects have been commissioned so far in the State as on 30.09.2010. Out of this 7.25 MW are the demonstration projects set up at Kondamedpally (2.75 MW), Narasimhakonda (2.50 MW) and Ramagiri (2.00 MW). In private sector 136.12 MW have been commissioned. The demonstration projects at Kondamedapally and Narasimhakonda are owned by NEDCAP with an aggregative capacity of 5.25 MW.

4 SOLAR ENERGY:

- 1) NEDCAP implements all solar energy programmes as per administrative guidelines issued by MNRE, GOI, New Delhi (Ministry of New & Renewable Energy) from time to time.
- 2) It is proposed to intimate the Physical Achievements of different solar energy programmes for the last the past 03 Programme Years i.e., from 2006-07, 2007-08, 2008-09, 2009-10 and the same are as follows:

There is no specific allocation of targets and funds to district wise basing on the received requisitions from O/o DM, NEDCAP concerned from time to time on first come first serve basis during the implementation period arranged supply & installation to concerned through approved suppliers as per MNRE specifications under the SPV Programmes from 2006-07 to 2008-09.

The MNRE, GOI from 2009-2010 onwards has not sanctioned any targets in advance. In turn instructed to submit proposals in Project mode to examine and sanction eligible CFA. Accordingly during the year 2009-10 MNRE has sanctioned eligible CFA of Rs.9600 for 19 Nos. in March, 2010 against sent proposals by NEDCAP. NEDCAP arranged supply & installations in the districts of Kurnool – 10 Nos, Prakasam – 04 Nos. & Vizianagaram – 05 Nos. to concerned in April/May, 2010.

The MNRE, GOI has announced detailed guidelines in respect of Grid Connected Power Plants and Programme on “Off-grid and Decentralised Solar Applications for the first phase of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Solar Mission (JNNSM) till 31st March, 2010 during 2010-11 in June/July/August, 2010 and the same may be seen in the websites of www.mnre.gov.in and to know the latest policies, administrative guidelines, eligible CFA and technical specifications, prescribed formats to submit proposals to MNRE to examine to accord sanction of the project and eligible CFA from time to time. And also suggested concerned to visit/witness the NEDCAP web site i.e., www.nedcap.gov.in from time to time.

5. **BIOMASS PRODUCTION, CONVERSION AND UTILIZATION TECHNOLOGY:**

1. Biomass power projects:

41 Biomass Power Projects of various capacities have been installed/commissioned up to 31.09.2010 in Andhra Pradesh State. The total installed capacity is 229.25 MW.

2. Bagasse based co-generation power projects:

23 Bagasse based Co-generation Power Projects of various capacities have been installed/commissioned up to 31.09.2010 in Andhra Pradesh State. The total installed capacity is 305.15 MW.

3. Biomass co-generation (non-bagasse) power projects:

11 Biomass co-generation (Non-bagasse) Power Projects have been installed/commissioned up to 31.09.2010 in Andhra Pradesh State. The total installed capacity is 36.75 MW.

6. POWER GENERATION THROUGH NON-CONVENTIONAL ENERGY SOURCES / MINI HYDEL PROJECTS:

Status of SHP projects in Andhra Pradesh:

The activity was transferred from erstwhile APSEB to NEDCAP vide G.O Ms.No.37 dated 01-02-1999 of Energy (power I) Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh.

The assessed hydro power potential is 1000 MW (approx). The status report on SHP projects is shown in annexure. The total no of projects sanctioned are 60 of 183.603 MW. The capacity harnessed so far is 96.353 MW through the Projects of 33 nos under private sector participation. The proposals/detailed project reports refereed to Irrigation Department for issuance of No Objection Certificate are aggregating to a total capacity of 300 MW.

The Government of Andhra Pradesh has announced policy on establishment of Mini Hydel Power Projects vide GO Ms.no.165 dated 11-07-2007 of I&CAD (Performs) department. As per GO, future registrations/allotment of sites to the private developers shall be under bidding process only.

7 POWER GENERATION THROUGH NON-CONVENTIONAL ENERGY SOURCES / INDUSTRIAL & MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE BASED POWER PROJECTS:

Objectives:

- i) To assess and upgrade various conversion technologies.
- ii) To create conducive conditions and environment, with fiscal and financial regime to develop, demonstrate and disseminate utilisation of wastes for recovery of energy.
- iii) To harness the available potential of MSW/Industrial Waste-to energy by the year 2017.

NEDCAP is authorized by the A.P. State Government vide . G.O. Ms. No. 253, E & F (RES) Department, dated 15-11-94 to sanction the Municipal Solid Waste/Industrial Waste based Power projects of capacity up to 20 MW. Andhra Pradesh is having various Industries which generate effluents. These effluents are to be treated to have value added product. The waste generated from Industries like starch, palm oil, distilleries, dairy, poultry, furfural etc., can be treated to generate Electricity.

An amount of Rs.15.00 Lakhs was sanctioned to create Energy Efficient lighting village by BEE, New Delhi for the year 2009-10. Accordingly, Pagidipally village of Nalgonda District has been taken up and completed the project with the amount of Rs.15.00 Lakhs.

II. The powers and duties of the officers and employees:

The Chairman, Board of Directors are appointed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh. The Chairman and Board of Directors are the Policy Making Body of the Corporation.

Vice-Chairman and Managing Director is being appointed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh and he is the Executive Head of the Corporation. VC & MD issues directions and closely monitors the activities of the corporation to achieve the objects for which the Corporation is incorporated. He convenes the Board Meetings as per the applicable provisions of Companies Act from time to time also appraises the Board on the issues to take decisions as required.

The VC & MD have Administrative, Statutory and Financial Powers.

The Vice-Chairman and Managing Director is assisted by the Function Heads. The following functions are headed by the Officers at Head Office as shown below:

General Manager

This post is having the status of top management level. He is the functional Head of Corporation.

Dy. General Manager (Technical)

This post is having the status of top management level. He is the Functional Head of Solar Energy and Wind Energy Sections.

Dy. General Manager (Finance & Accounts)

This post is having the status of top management level. He is the Functional Head of Finance, Accounts & Secretarial Matters Sections.

Manager (Admn)

This post is having the status of top management level. He is the Functional Head of Administration and Legal Wing.

Project Directors/Executive Engineers:

This post is having the status of management level and each activity is headed by a Project Director/Executive Engineer at Head Office.

Project Directors/Executive Engineers/District Managers at Districts:

This post is having the status of management level and each district is headed by a Project Director/Executive Engineer/District Manager.

All the above officers are supported by Middle, Junior, Supervisory and Supporting Staff.

The Organization Chart is enclosed.

All important decisions are taken by Government / Board / Vice- Chairman and Managing Director. The proposals will be initiated by Middle, Junior, Supervisory and Supporting Staff and will be processed through the concerned functional head, who gives its recommendations and finally decision will be taken by the Vice-Chairman and Managing Director or by Board after going through the agenda / or by Government as the case may be. The Vice-Chairman and Managing Director has delegated some of the administrative powers to the General Manager & other Functional Heads viz. Dy. General Managers, Project Directors, Executive Engineers & District Managers of the Corporation.

Since the programmes are being sponsored by Ministry of New & Renewable Energy and Bureau of Energy Efficiency, Government of India, such as National Biogas and Manure Management Programme, Solar Energy, Mini Hydel Scheme and Energy Conservation, certain incentives are being extended. The norms set by MNRE, Government of India is being followed in their respective function. Similarly, the instructions of State Government for the programmes of Improved Chulhas and as well as Energy Conservation are being followed.
